

Short Bio of Animesh Jain:

Animesh Jain obtained his Ph.D. in Theoretical Nuclear Physics in 1978 from Birla Institute of Technology and Science in India. He worked on application of ion beams and high-power lasers to materials at the Bhabha Atomic Research Center, Mumbai, India after completing his Ph.D. He entered the field of superconducting magnets and magnetic measurements in 1991 working on the Relativistic Heavy Ion Collider (RHIC) at Brookhaven National Laboratory in New York, USA. He has been responsible for measurements of magnets for several major accelerator projects such as RHIC, Spallation Neutron Source (SNS), and NSLS-II. He joined Argonne National Laboratory in 2016 and has led the development of magnetic measurements for the Advanced Photon Source Upgrade project. Animesh is also a long-time member of the IMMW International Advisory Committee.
